Consultation has concluded



The Barwon South West Waste and Resource Recovery Group (Group) has finalised consultation on their draft regional implementation plan.

The Group consulted on the draft plan from 14 July to 12 August 2016 - thank you to all stakeholders that provided feedback.

About the draft plan

The draft plan sets out the waste and resource recovery (recycling) infrastructure needs (facilities and equipment) of the Barwon South West region for the next 10 years. The draft plan also looks at ways to minimise the environmental and public health impacts of waste while supporting a cost effective recycling system which reduces dependence on landfill.
