- Provide practical support to the waste and resource recovery groups (WRRGs) and local councils to facilitate collaborative procurement of waste and resource recovery services and infrastructure.
- Act as a catalyst for more collaborative procurement for waste and resource recovery services and infrastructure and operate as a broker for the WRRGs and local government.
- Respond to the individual needs of the WRRGs by providing guidance to identify, assess and plan collaborative procurement.
- Build capability and expertise in collaborative procurement in key organisations including SV, WRRGs, local government and third party service providers.

Support mechanism		Description
8	WRR technical overviews – fact sheets	Information on relevant WRR solutions to improve the literacy of WRRGs and local councils in WRR industry / infrastructure.
9	Training and tailored workshops on WRR solutions	Development and delivery of training and tailored workshops on specific WRR solutions to build on the improved literacy of WRRGs and local councils in WRR industry / infrastructure. SV acknowledges that there is an appetite for increased knowledge and awareness in emerging WRR options. SV will explore how this could be delivered but in the short-term will integrate with other SV opportunities including the SWRRIP, Investment Facilitation Framework, Community and Business Waste Education Strategy and the Victorian Organic Resource Recovery Strategy.
10	Collaborative procurement cost model	Collaborative procurement cost model to inform procurement options and development of tender documents (ties into SV's Data Governance Framework) and improved business case development.
11	Access to and sharing of data	Centralised data store of accurate and current data on waste generation, existing facilities, demographics to inform collaborative procurement options and the development of tender documents.

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Collaborative Procurement Framework: project engagement timeline

- **Stage 1: July to August 2014**

Collaborative Procurement Framework has finished this stage

Research and targeted waste and resource recovery group (WRRG) and select council consultation to determine practical support to facilitate an increase in collaborative procurement in waste and resource recovery.

- **Stage 2: 22 September to 31 October 2014**

Collaborative Procurement Framework has finished this stage

Business / industry and government consultation (workshops and online) to test the proposed support mechanisms that will inform the development of the Collaborative Procurement Framework.
