

# Loddon Mallee Waste and Resource Recovery Implementation Plan

Consultation has concluded



The Loddon Mallee Waste and Resource Recovery Group (Group) has finalised consultation on their draft regional implementation plan.

The Group consulted on the draft plan from 18 July to 12 August 2016 - thank you to all stakeholders that provided feedback.

## About the draft plan

The draft plan sets out the waste and resource recovery (recycling) infrastructure needs (facilities and equipment) of the Loddon Mallee region for the next 10 years. The draft plan also looks at ways to minimise the environmental and public health impacts of waste while supporting a cost effective recycling system which reduces dependence on landfill.

## Previous consultation

In early 2016 the Group invited local governments and waste and resource recovery businesses to make landfill scheduling applications as the region determined its landfill air space needs up to 2026. More information is available in the Document Library on the right hand side of this web page.
