

## Amendments to the Guide

The *Guide to Best Practice at Resource Recovery and Waste Transfer Facilities* was published to this website on 14 July 2004. Subsequently, minor amendments were made to the document and second version published on 20 July 2004. The amendments made are as follows:

**Section 1.7, page 2. Statutory Framework**

Change wording from “specific sections” to “specific segments” of the environment”.

**Section 2.1, page 4. Needs Assessment**

Added dot point "increase resource recovery".

**Section 2.2, page 5. Determining Material Pathways**

Added dot point "hard waste".

**Section 3.3, page 10, WASTE OIL**

Added reference to EcoRecycle guidelines and operator training manual.

Added note regarding “currently domestic use only”.

**Section 3.5, page 14. Plant and Equipment**

Typo, “ESB” not “EBS”.

**Section 3.6, page 14. Design For Traffic Access And Flow**

All facilities should have a traffic management plan - not must.

**Section 4.1, page 17. Occupational Health and Safety Risks**

A Job Safety Analysis should be conducted for all tasks that occur onsite - not only for tasks that occur on a regular basis.

**Section 4.5, page 23. Hazardous or Prescribed Waste**

General Requirements, add “from domestic sources”, first paragraph.

Included note regarding on-site storage.

**Section 4.5, page 23, Asbestos**

Corrected reference to the EPA publication.

EPA Publication 364C

"The Transport and Disposal of Waste Asbestos" October 2002.

**Section 4.5, page 23, Hazardous or Prescribed Waste**

"Gas bottles" and "Liquid wastes" now appear under separate headings.

**Section 4.5, page 23, Hazardous or Prescribed Waste**

Reference to ChemCollect deleted.

**Section 6.2, page 32, Environmental and Planning**

Amended title of EPA Publication 364C

"The Transport and Disposal of Waste Asbestos" October 2002.
