

MODEL CONTRACT CLAUSES
FOR
WASTE MINIMISATION PLANS

Either developers or local government can use the following contract clauses. The clauses have been designed so that they can readily be inserted into any formal agreement between the aforementioned parties and contractors responsible for any project of a construction and/or demolition nature.

Waste Minimisation Plan

- (a) The contractor (or contractors, including sub-contractors) engaged to undertake any construction or demolition activity must ensure that before any person commences work, a waste minimisation plan that complies with the provisions of this section has been submitted (to Council / to Developer)
- (b) An authorised officer (of the Council / Developer) may require a person lodging a waste minimisation plan to amend the plan in order to comply with stated requirements
- (c) A waste minimisation plan must include the following information:
 - i. Name of the contractor company, address and contact name and contact details
 - ii. Site details including project address (where the waste is being generated)
 - iii. A description of the waste
 - Description of the type of waste material
 - Estimated quantity of waste material
 - Method of disposal (reuse on site/off site, resale, recycle, landfill)

Failure to comply

- (a) A person must not dispose of any material in a manner contrary to the provisions of a waste minimisation plan, or an amended Waste management plan, he or she has lodged in accordance with the provisions of this part without first obtaining prior written approval from an authorised officer.
